

AFSP accelerates sustainability agenda for the adhesive tape industry

2021 saw the launch of the Afera Flagship Sustainability Project (AFSP), which aims to translate the European Green Deal to Afera Members and provide the tape industry with the required tools and guidance.

The project has been in full swing since the kick-off meetings in November, and already 2 rounds of monthly meetings have taken place to identify key action points per Workstream.



3 Workstreams (WSs) have been defined with the key project goals to

- Develop harmonised calculation methods for environmental impact of all types of adhesive tapes (WS1).
- Improve the management of waste that is generated during tape manufacture and use (WS2).
- Anticipate upcoming sustainability regulations and engage with relevant stakeholders to advocate for the tape value chain (WS3)
