# **Regulatory affairs**

- A Technical Committee expert group focussed on regulatory affairs, led by Afera's Public Affairs Manager

- Facilitation of a joint industry approach to submitting input into the update of the BAT Reference Document (BREF) 'Surface Treatment Using Organic Solvents (STS)' under the IED through our membership in the BREF STS Technical Working Group
- Representation of REACH downstream users (DUs) through our seat in the partner expert group in CheMI, the European Platform for Chemicals Using Manufacturing Industries
- Collaboration on overlapping issues with FEICA (the Association of the European Adhesive and Sealant Industry), such as member companies' joint monitoring of PACT/RMOA substances under REACH
- Collaboration with IVK (the German Adhesives Association) in monitoring and participating in the meetings and initiatives of the European Recovered Paper Council (ERPC)
- Close links with Cefic (The European Chemical Industry Council) and other organisations in adjacent technologies.

- Chairmanship of Afera TC member Lutz Jacob of Working Group 7 (Tapes) of CEN (European Committee for Standardisation) TC 193 (Adhesives)
- Support in maintenance and periodic reviews of ISO 29862:2007 Peel Adhesion, ISO 29863:2007 Shear Adhesion, and ISO 29864:2007 Breaking Strength and Elongation TMs
- Release of the 2019 edition of the Afera Test Methods Manual
- Planned creation of Afera TM tutorial videos available to members at a dedicated YouTube channel.


